Shorts (Seasonal, August–October 1; May 1–End of School Year)	
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● <b>Style:</b> <u>Loose-fitting</u>, bermuda-length (10" to 12" inseam) or longer, dress/formal style. <i>No denim or denim-like material.</i></li> <li>● <b>Color:</b> Solid navy, khaki beige, gray, or black</li> </ul>

### Where to Find Shorts

- Search: *bermuda length, 10" or 11" or 12" inseam, chino shorts*
- JCPenney, Walmart, Lands' End, Kohl's, The Children's Place, French Toast, etc.
- Note: Online stores offer more selection

### Acceptable Shorts for Dress Down Days

- Bermuda length or longer
- Must cover most of the thigh and fit loosely
- Denim *is* allowed
- Not allowed: Athletic shorts; sweatpant-material



## Violations of the ICS Dress Code

- Tears, rips, or holes
- Leggings or spandex worn as shorts or pants; bike shorts
- Too short of a length (less than a 9" inseam)
- Too-tight or too-loose of a fit (Shorts must be worn in an appropriate manner, not baggy or below the waist.)

**Parents of students in violation of the ICS Dress Code will be called and will need to bring approved clothing for their student to change into at school.**
